

Organizational Board Meetings

The Board shall organize/reorganize annually.

During the first regular meeting in April in even-numbered years, the Board shall reorganize.

During a March meeting in odd-numbered years, the Board establishes a date for its organizational meeting to be held sometime after the election authority canvasses the vote, but within 28 days after the consolidated election. The consolidated election is held on the first Tuesday in April of odd-numbered years. If, however, that date conflicts with the celebration of Passover, the consolidated election is postponed to the first Tuesday following the last day of Passover.

At the organizational meeting in odd-numbered years the following shall occur:

1. Each successful candidate, before taking his or her seat on the Board, shall take the oath of office as provided in the board policy regarding board member oath and conduct.
2. The new board members shall be seated.
3. The board members shall ascribe to the "Code of Conduct" as provided in the policy regarding board member oath and conduct.

At each annual organizational/reorganizational meeting the following shall occur:

1. The Board shall elect its officers who assume office immediately upon their election.
2. The Board shall fix a time and date for its regular meetings.
