



pbis is a proactive process for creating safer and more effective schools. Chiddix has used this process for the past four years.

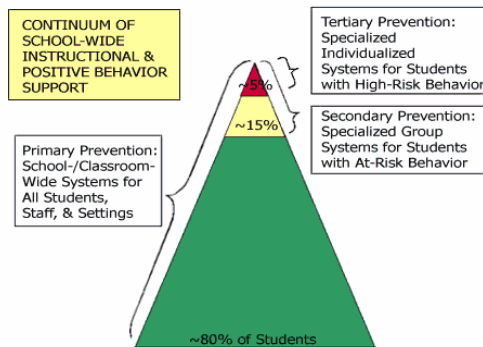
pbis is based on teaching students expected behaviors and rewarding them when they are demonstrated. The expectations at Chiddix Junior High School fall under three basic categories: **respect, responsibility, and safety.**

Behavioral Tracking

Behavioral tracking is also an important part of **pbis**. Faculty and staff members use red slips (see *back of brochure*) for minor incidents and to record major offenses. This data is stored in the Skyward data management system which is maintained through the Unit 5 school district. This information is reviewed by the CJHS pbis team, and then utilized to make decisions about problem areas in the building and/or particular students.

Behavioral Tracking *cont.*

In **pbis**, students are categorized by three colors (see *image below*).



Green students are students who need little or no reminders about expectations.

Yellow students are students that might need several reminders or minor consequences to attain expectations.

Red students are students that need frequent reminders or consequences to reach the targets.

Students who fall into the yellow and red categories might need specific behavioral and/or academic interventions to help them attain achievement targets. These plans are developed by the academic teams in cooperation with the student, parents, guidance counselors, and CJHS administration. Each individual has a role to play in the successful implementation of the plan.

Chiddix Reward System

Charger Choice Awards, “Monthly Winners” drawings, and Quarterly Rewards (*more information on back of brochure*) are initiatives Chiddix has created for reinforcement of positive behavior within the school community.

Charger Choice Awards (CCA) are distributed by faculty and staff members to students for various reasons: helping others, taking initiative, etc. Each rewarded student has an opportunity to “cash in” his or her award for prizes listed on the CCA – such as a free bag of popcorn on “Popcorn Fridays,” free admission to any CJHS sponsored athletic event, moving to the front of the lunch line, or choosing from an assortment of prizes in the main office.

Drawings for “Monthly Winners” happen at the end of each month during lunch hours. All “cashed in” Charger Choice Awards are saved for one month, and these awards are drawn during each lunch hour to win cash, gift cards, and other prizes.

Quarterly Rewards Policy

Charger Choice Awards, along with monthly drawings, are used to reinforce positive behavior within the student body at CJHS.

Chiddix also continues to strengthen the building's theme of *respect, responsibility, and safety* by rewarding students who have not had any office discipline referrals and have passed all of their classes for the quarter.

Number of individual red slips reset quarterly.


Red slips are a behavior intervention technique used inside and outside of the classroom to track student respectfulness, responsibility, and safety.
