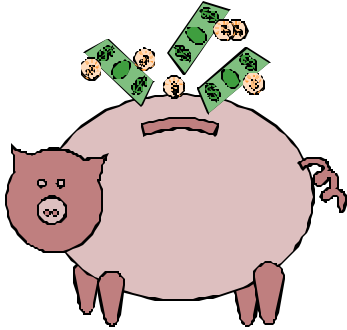

INTERRELATED COOPERATIVE EDUCATION

(1.5 Credits per Semester) (11, 12)

Prerequisite: 16 Years of Age with Junior Standing

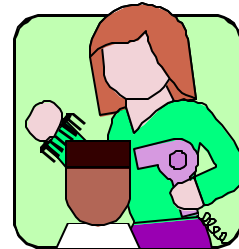
The Interrelated Cooperative Education program is designed to provide occupational training on a part-time basis for high school students. The student spends one-half day in the high school attending regular classes, the other half-day is spent as an employed student-learner being trained at a local business or industry. Classroom instruction includes specific related lessons pertaining to the job and general related information topics such as social security, employer-employee relations, labor standards, unions, income tax, personal budget, money management, etc.



Any student wishing to enroll in Interrelated Cooperative Education must complete the following procedure or he/she will not be considered for the program:

Get Co-op application from their counselor, fill it out, get parent signature, then return completed form to the counselor.

NOTE: Alternate courses must be selected in the event a student is not selected for the co-op program.



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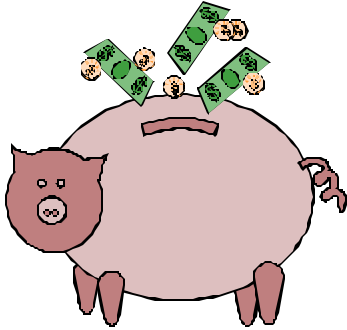
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
