



**Schedule your immunization appointments NOW
for the 2010-2011 school year!
Your child will not be allowed at school the first day
if he or she is not current on immunizations.**

The McLean County Health Department offers vaccinations to McLean County students who are eligible for the Vaccine for Children PLUS program. These are students who :

- ☀ Are enrolled in Medicaid or All Kids
- ☀ Are American Indian or Alaskan Native
- ☀ Do not have health insurance
- ☀ Have health insurance that does not pay for vaccines

*If your child does not meet any of the above requirements,
schedule an immunization appointment with his or her doctor.*

Please note:

1. Students must be well and have a shot record.
2. Parent, legal guardian or authorized proxy must accompany students under 18.
3. Grade levels usually needing immunizations are kindergarten, 6th and 9th grades.
