



## Soar with Reading! January 8-February 19, 2010

Dear Colene Hoose Families:

It's time for our annual winter reading program. This year the theme is "Soar with Reading!" Students should read, or have read to them, a total of 600 minutes during the six weeks (or 20 minutes of recreational reading 5 nights a week). Students who achieve their reading goal will receive a ticket good for admission to any Six Flags theme park during the summer of 2010 (**between the dates of June 14, and August 8, 2010**).

Because we realize that not every child may have the opportunity to go to Six Flags, we will reward all students who reach their reading goal with a trip to the Normal Theater in March. Students will travel by bus to see a special showing of the movie, "Up." Please support this program by encouraging your child to read, or by spending time reading to them. **Time students spend reading for the Pizza Hut Book-It program, book reports, or other reading programs in their classrooms will also count for this program.**

On the back of this sheet is the Student Tally Sheet, which your child will use to keep a record of his/her reading. Students in grades K-2 have balloons to color to record their progress and 3<sup>rd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> graders have a chart. If 3<sup>rd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> grade students fill the tally sheet, feel free to use other paper and attach it to this sheet. Minutes can also be consolidated after several nights of reading so that just one space is used.
