Float Construction Regulations

1. There is no set limit on the amount of money each organization may spend on their float. Any amount of material may be borrowed or donated.
2. An adult must be present at all work sessions.
3. Floats must be extracurricular projects. Students may not be excused from school to work on floats. Some students may be allowed to leave on the day of the parade to assist in transporting an entry to NCHS. This dismissal must be arranged in cooperation with the school sponsor and principal.

Parade Route (through the Eagle's Landing subdivision)

Start at NCHS—West on Raab—South on Airport—West on Sheppard—North on Meadowlark—West on Butterfly—North on Agate Way—West on Turquoise Way—North on Lodge Pole Lane—East on Raab—End at NCHS

Parade Regulations

1. **Candy** – Candy may NOT be thrown from the float. However, "walkers" can distribute candy during the parade route.
2. **Drivers** – All motor vehicles must have a licensed driver who is at least 21 years old.

Motor entries must comply with the Town of Normal fire regulations. Floats must be inspected at the site for compliance. All floats must carry a fire extinguisher.

3. **Clubs/Sports/Organizations** – All entries must be clearly identified with posters on both sides of the float/vehicle. You will need to provide your own posters, string, balloons, etc.

All entries must be decorated and are encouraged to follow the theme – “**Safari**”.

Decorated cars and trucks will be allowed as parade entries and must comply with all regulations.

Cars may not transport more than six passengers.

“Class Boards” may have up to two cars for officers.

Decorated entries must be dismantled immediately after the parade in the NCHS parking lot under the supervision of an adult. Please be sure to dispose of all trash.

4. **Check-in** – Check-in will begin at 7:30 a.m. Friday morning in the NCHS northwest parking lot (near the tennis courts). All entries must arrive no later than 1:30 p.m. Each group is responsible for the supervision of its entry.

A few days before the parade you will be e-mailed or sent a map indicating your “entry number” and parking location.

5. **Horses** – Horses may be used in the parade only if the entry provides its own clean-up immediately following the entry.
6. **Politicians** – Government officials and candidates running for office are welcome to participate in the parade.
