

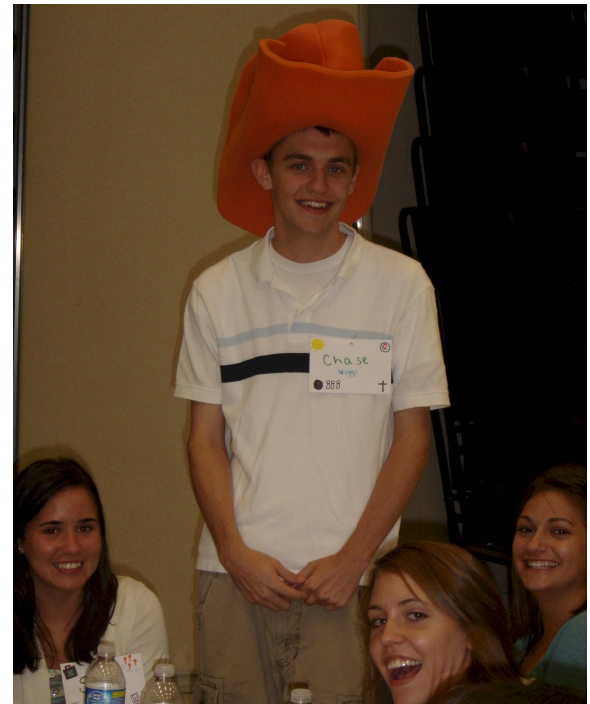
NCHS ROCS
