The April minutes were approved.

Mr. Joel Swanson, NCHS Biology teacher, came to the meeting to thank IronPride for the money for the projectors and the rats that were approved at the April meeting.

Treasurer Peggy Feldman noted that IronPride was \$6,173.49 over the projected 2005-2006 budget of \$27,250. A large part of that was due to the start up of the IronPride Café. We are currently trying to sell out of supplies at the café and the store so as not to have to buy more merchandise before the end of the school year. The total funds dispersed for the 2005-2006 school year were \$33,423.49. The proposed budget of \$32,250 for the 2006-2007 school year was unanimously approved.

Dr. Nuckolls thanked IronPride for the staff luncheon on May 3. She also expressed her thanks for the support and activities during the past school year. IronPride taking over the operation of concessions at sporting events was a huge plus. Dr. Nuckolls also expressed her thanks for the scholarships given to the seniors. There will be a commemorative ceremony on May 20 at 11:00 a.m. where a 3-ton engraved rock will be dedicated at the original NCHS site on Kingsley Avenue. Dr. Al Bowman from ISU will be the keynote speaker at baccalaureate. Dr. Nuckolls asked for input on how best to remember the three students from the graduating class who passed away. As of today, there are 1,791 students enrolled for next year. A list of IronPride officers for next year was requested. Dr. Nuckolls also needs the name of a possible CAC representative. Wednesday is the retirement reception from 3:30-5:00 for Jeannette Byers, Dennis Sackett, and Karna Croft. Dr. Nuckolls would like to give Dennis Sackett a NCHS hat a black polo shirt. Items from the Spirit Store are needed for the goodie bags for new staff members. The Unit 5 board has approved a third assistant principal for NCHS. The position has been posted and there have been four applicants already.

Committee Reports

Spirit Store. Colleen Liesman asked if she needed a receipt to return items that haven't sold. Colleen is going to have a sale at the Spirit Store on Monday, May 22, to try to get rid of as much as possible.

Café. Margie Traeger's family got the newly donated refrigerator to the café and set up. Margie asked that the staff return items borrowed from the café, and also to see that they are clean.

Special Events. Marcia Reabe reported that distributing the treats for the PSAE testing on April 26 & 27 went well. She served brownies, Rice Krispie Treats, and lemonade. Teacher Appreciation was successful, but Marcia had a hard time finding people to

donate and provide food. All the teachers were given plants, and the tables at the luncheon were decorated with balloons. The staff was very appreciative.

Webmaster. Tom Nielsen reports that he has new software for the site in order to better update the information. As of yesterday, there were 3,866 hits on the site. Prom and after-prom pictures will be on the website soon.

Water. Margie reports that there is a huge inventory of left over soda, and the Coke representative is going to come and pick up the extra.

Publicity. Darla Sandel reports that there was not enough time to put together the proposed spring sports program and get the money from the sponsors. The plan is to start in the fall of '06 to have a program ready for '07 spring sports. Darla would like to have a comprehensive list of rules to work under for advertising. There is a web-related ad agency called Athletics 2000 that will give 50% of proceeds from ads to the athletic department.

There was no report from Concessions or Volunteers.

New Business. Peg Donaldson from the NCHS Vocational Ed program requested \$311.99 from next year's budget for a time clock and time cards.
