There were no requests for funds.

Treasurer Peggy Feldman reports that as of today, there is \$4,081.79 in the IronPride account. In the 2006-2007 school year, \$5,243.04 was spent for Hospitality/Special Events; a \$6,524.95 profit was made in the café; a \$6,877.34 profit was made from candy sales; and a \$8,780.43 profit was made from clothing sales. A brief discussion followed on the amount spent on Hospitality/Special Events. IronPride awarded \$2,000 in scholarships and \$15,548 in donations.

Principal's Report. Dr. Nuckolls expressed how much the teachers and staff sincerely appreciate all that the hospitality committee provides. There are two weeks of school left, and the senior activities are going smoothly. The baccalaureate program on Sunday went well, but it went a bit long. Unit 5 has hired ISU policemen for security at graduation. There will be one officer posted on every level at Braden Auditorium and one posted in the lobby. Officer Jerry Worden will be retiring June 1, and Officer Mike Dowd will be his replacement. Dr. Nuckolls reports that a letter has been sent home to the parents of all seniors asking that no guests bring air horns to graduation. IronPride needs to select a new CAC representative for the coming year.

Committee Reports

Pam Wylder from the Spirit Store reports that she and Colleen Liesman met to order new items for the store for next year. Pam brought samples of new sweatshirts to this meeting for the board to view. Terri Heid stated that the Alumni Board would like to purchase as many remaining school Christmas ornaments as possible for a function they are having over the summer. Pam will check on how many are left. Colleen and Pam are going to have shopping bags printed for purchases from the Spirit Store. This will be great advertising for the store.

Café/Concessions. Margie Traeger reports that everything is going well. The café will be open all this week and next, but will not be open during finals. After Memorial Day, prices in the café will be marked down to the purchase cost. Margie has been receiving requests for people to work in the café next year already. Julie Stokke and Judy Jiles will co-chair the café committee next year. Terri Heid spoke to Mr. Starkey about the NCHS Business Department helping run the café and possibly the Spirit Store. He will get back to Terri after thinking it over.

Webmaster Tom Nielsen reports that he is proud of the success of the NCHS IronPride site, and he has had fun operating it for the past four years. Felicia Harrison will be taking over the operation of the site.

Starting Wednesday, May 23 will be library book check-in. Help is needed Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday of this week and Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of next week.
