

Terri Heid called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

The minutes from May were approved.

The following requests for funds were presented. Paulette Johnson, representing the volleyball parents, requested help purchasing 100 "toss-out" t-shirts for the home varsity games. The total cost of purchasing and printing the t-shirts is \$450. The team has already done some fundraising, and the shirts would help to promote school spirit at the games. A motion was brought forth and passed to grant the team the full \$450. Terry Mester, National Honor Society Sponsor, asked for help in purchasing a banner saying both "National Honor Society" and "Normal Community High School." The banner will be used at the NHS induction ceremonies, with a total cost of \$279--\$195 for the banner, \$75 for the lettering, and \$9 for shipping. A motion was brought forth and passed to grant the full \$279. Anne Libert, representing the Social Studies Department, requested funds to purchase 6 DVD players to use in the classrooms, with a total cost of \$650. A decision has been put on hold pending further discussion.

Treasurer's Report. Peggy Feldman reported that \$15,424 of NCHS clothing was purchased at registration. The No Hassle Fund Raiser has brought in \$3,880 so far, which is already more than was brought in last year. Total revenue is down approximately \$6,000-\$7,000 compared to this time last year. The budget report was approved.

Principal's Report. Dr. Nuckolls expressed a huge thank you for all of the help given at registration. As of Friday, August 18, 2006, NCHS 2006-2007 enrollment is 1,863. Due to the large number of registered freshman, the school has run out of freshman lockers, placing some of the freshman in the senior hallway. Dr. Nuckolls also expressed her thanks for the gifts IronPride presented to the new teachers.

Committee Reports.

The Spirit Store is stocked and ready for Wednesday, the first 1/2 day of school. Tom Nielsen is helping Colleen Liesman set up the e-mail list for volunteers.

Teri Carroll Miller from Special Events reports that the volunteers are ready to help with the teacher luncheon on Wednesday, August 23, the first 1/2 day of school. Special Events will help with the Open House on September 14th at 6:30. The Back-To-School Dance is Friday, September 8 after the home football game.

Kathy Bohn for Tom Nielsen reports that the website is updated. Please check all names and e-mails for accuracy. The Un-raiser form is on the website. It was noted that the

contact person for the café needs to be changed on the website from Terri Heid to Carol John. Margie Traeger's name needs to be removed as the contact person for water. Kate Rodriguez has volunteered to maintain the website after this school year.

Sue Hedrick, chairperson of the Greeter program, reports that she received two pages of names to volunteer as greeters.

Darla Sandel needs to resign her position as head of Publicity due to health issues in her family. The program for spring sports remains the most pressing task of the committee. We need to find a volunteer to research what would be expected of NCHS and the cost involved and present a report at the next meeting. Becky Traeger volunteered to contact You-Name-It Sports to see how they can work with NCHS.

Becky Cobert, Judy Fritzen, Pat Powers, Janie Zalesiak, Kristy Lykkebak, Carol John, and Margie Traeger are the members of the newly-formed Concessions/Café committee. Their objective is to give direction for the operation of the café and the concessions. The café can be manned by groups for \$25/day or \$125/week. A new popcorn machine is needed if the current one cannot be fixed. A new popcorn machine is approximately \$600. A motion was brought forth and passed to allocate funds to fix the current popcorn popper or to purchase a new one for up to \$700. IronPride will run the football concession on September 22, 2006. The committee is working on a formula for assigning concessions to the various groups at NCHS.

New Business. A project is currently being planned with the parent group at NCWHS to sell a t-shirt with both an Ironman and a Wildcat saying "Rivalry on Raab Road." The NCHS t-shirts would be orange, and the West t-shirts would be gray.

The next meeting will be Monday, September 18, 2006 in the IMC.
