The meeting was called to order by President Julie Lauritson at 6:30pm.

### Information Items – Old Business

- The May minutes were presented and discussed. Bobbi Price motioned to accept the minutes as written. Diana Weekes seconded. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer's Report was discussed.

### Discussion Items

- Concession Fund Raising  
Jeff Elliot with Vemma Nutrition along with Troy Gee (Booster member) made a brief presentation of a healthier alternative to our current use of sports/energy drinks in our Concession stands. Along with a PowerPoint show, several handouts, pricing charts and samples, Jeff presented a very concise, logical argument to replace our current drink. Although it is a very healthy drink and a wonderful opportunity for Boosters to make a profit on not only the stand sales but also any further area sales to parents and schools, Boosters will still need to be able to sell it at our stand so it was agreed that a 'taste testing' would occur during the Fall Kickoff.
- Brick Fundraising Update  
Randy has the brick trifolds almost ready. He did present a sample order form. We will really push this at Registration. Randy needs input on how to reach alumni and will try Facebook as a source. Bellas ([www.bellaslandscaping.com](http://www.bellaslandscaping.com)) will be presenting our Brick Project to area businesses on our behalf also. We have been encouraged by Normal West Administration to have a table at not only Open House but any large event.
- Lottery  
It was decided to postpone our lottery until August 22<sup>nd</sup> (time and place tba). As all of the levels have not been notified of the new system and not all teams have had tryouts, it was agreed that to be fair, we should wait. The first football game was quickly approaching however and as Soccer and Varsity Cheerleading were present, it was approved to give them the first event.
- Fund Requests  
Athletic Director, Stan Lewis, was not present and no fund requests were made. It was mentioned that due to the new Concession system, it was possible that less funds would be available to any group. Boosters are encouraging teams to take the initiative to 'fund raise' by working the stands now.
- Fall Kickoff  
Mike Jerome reported that most of the fall sports are participating. Flyers will be posted and sent out. Mike will have a 50/50 as well as a silent auction. Mike is buying the pork chops (to be reimbursed) from Bloomington Meats. Bobbi will buy everything else for the event. Ticket prices are set at \$7 for the sandwich, chips, cookie and beverage.
- 50% Membership Incentive  
If a team has fifty percent Booster members, the team will receive \$250. Levels of sports are considered separate entities. It was suggested that Parent Representatives really push this at meetings as it is an easy way to earn money.

Our next Booster Club meeting is September 2<sup>nd</sup> at 6:30 in the IMC. The meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm.
