### Information Items

- Old Business

  - The Brick Sale was on display during most of the Football games this season. Randy will look into a way to display during Basketball events. It was mentioned that a permanent display near the front office might be beneficial. Randy requested to purchase an easel to display the professionally printed sign. Julie is pursuing PayPal as a way to accept credit card payments for our bricks. A large Booster banner will be ordered for advertisement for the Brick project. As this is an ongoing project - the banner will be substantial to last a few years.
  - There was some discussion regarding our annual Purse Sale. Julie will contact the Poms coach to see what date they will be hosting the Jr. Poms night. This event brings in lots of young girls and parents. The Purse Sale does not cost the Boosters any money so it's an easy and fun fundraiser.

### New Business

- Lisa will be following up with You Name It Sports. Previously, the sports programs were not very nice and the publisher was difficult to work with. Unit 5 is now using a local publisher and the quality has greatly improved. Boosters would like to have in the seasonal sports programs (not Intercity programs) an ad for the club itself as well as a larger ad for our Brick Effort. We would like to have a few magazines to sell in the stand as well as a 'public service' rather than a fundraiser.
- Julie will contact the school's PawPrint publication for advertising opportunities.
- It was mentioned that we might need to address the Bylaws as the attendance at our meetings has lessened dramatically.
