

## NCWHS Booster Club Minutes September 2nd, 2009

The meeting was called to order by President Julie Lauritson at 6:30 pm.

### Information Items - Old Business

- The August minutes were presented. Randy Klante made a motion to accept the minutes as written. Tiffany Williams seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Treasurer's report was deferred to meeting end.

### Discussion Items

- Fund requests  
One fund request, submitted by Athletic Director Stan Lewis, was presented. Stan was unable to attend. The request is for \$2458 to replace 36 team chairs for gymnasium use. The request was tabled until the October meeting. Motion by Tiffany Williams and seconded by Bobbi Price to add to October agenda.
- Introduction of members. Welcome Freshman Parents!
- Verve  
Troy Gee gave an update on the new website format. He reported on the success of samples at both football and volleyball. 4Packs are available at a cost of \$7.50 with a \$15 or \$20 selling price for fundraising event.
- Pork chops Fall Kickoff. A report was presented by Julie Lauritson. Despite the weather, 150 pork chops were sold. The remainder will be sold at home football games. Concession took in \$872 including 50/50 and membership /parking passes took in an additional \$565.
- Concession Lottery Volunteers  
No huge response initially, additional notices were sent and all participants received two concession dates.
- Membership  
To date, Varsity Volleyball, Varsity Boys Soccer, Varsity Cheerleading and Girls Swimming have 50% membership and will receive \$250 each as the membership incentive.
- Banner information was distributed to members with interest.
- Brick Fundraiser  
A kick off event is necessary to promote interest. Recommendation to hold kick-off in conjunction with homecoming in order to attract alumni. Idea for a mechanical bull with the brick information to take place after homecoming parade. Motion was made by Troy Gee to secure the mechanical bull, seconded by Bobbi Price. Julie will pursue securing the bull for 3 hours and contact Mr. Eder for approval.

### New Business

- All membership items have been paid for. Additional items have been ordered from a new company with lower prices. Additional items to replace existing are blankets, sling bags, t-shirts, and polo shirts. An additional order of chairs was made. The initial 48 are taken.
- New locks have been installed on all cabinets in the concession stands.
- Treasurer's report was presented. Motion by Troy Gee to accept report as presented, seconded by Diana Weekes.
