### Educational Benefits

Nursing students may compete for an Army Nurse Scholarship. All Nursing scholarships cover the following:

- 100% tuition/fees **OR** room/board
- \$1200/year book allowance
- \$300-\$500/month for 10 months
- Onetime payment of \$650 at the beginning of your junior year for uniforms, immunizations, equipment, etc.
- Pre-NCLEX test and your first NCLEX
