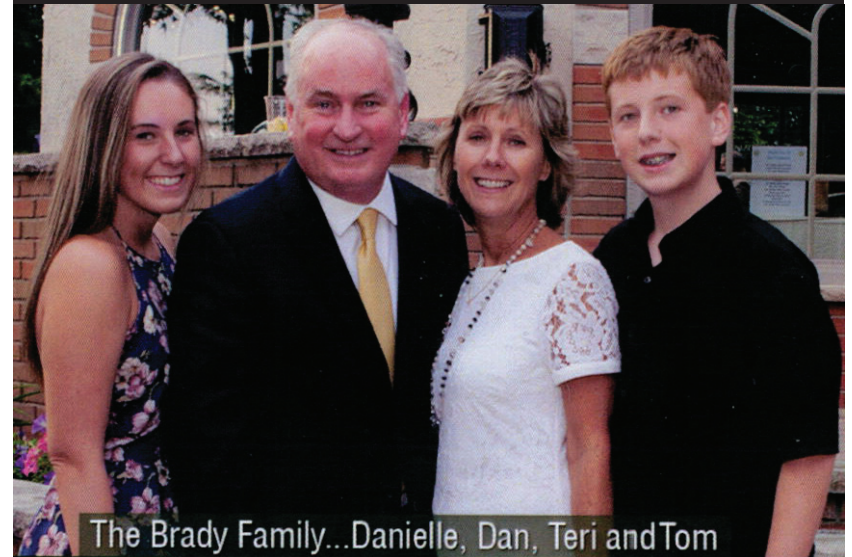

DIRECTORS' NOTES

Vernon & McWhorter

"Thomas Jefferson once said that all men are created equal. There is a tendency in this year of grace for certain people to use this phrase out of context, to satisfy all conditions. We know all men are not created equal in the sense some people would have us believe – some people are smarter than others, some people have more opportunity because they're born with it, some men make more money than others, some people make better cakes than others – some people are born gifted beyond the normal scope of most men.

"But there is one way in this country in which all men are created equal – there is one human institution that makes a pauper the equal of a Rockefeller, the stupid man the equal of an Einstein, and the ignorant man the equal of any college president. That institution is a court. It can be the Supreme Court of the United States or the humblest J.P. court in the land. Our courts have their faults, as does any human institution, but in this country our courts are the great levelers, and in our courts all men are created equal.

"I'm no idealist to believe firmly in the integrity of our courts and in the jury system – that is no ideal to me; it is a living, working reality. A court is only as sound as its jury, and a jury is only as sound as the men who make it up."
