The Tempest is one of the last things Shakespeare ever wrote, but it is presented first in the First Folio, the earliest compilation of the Bard's work. It is suggested that the playwright wrote it for the engagement party of King James' daughter, and was therefore done indoors in Whitehall theatre with a great deal of special effects, spectacle, and flash. We hope we have done it justice.





- IVi Prospero celebrates Ferdinand and Miranda's marriage, but it all ends when he sees Caliban's plot. Stephano, Trinculo, and Caliban are chased by hell hounds.
- Vi Prospero forgives his enemies, reunites a repentant Alonso with his son, and frees Ariel, returning to Milan to die.
