- Connect Transit Suspending Fare Collection
 - Effective March 18, 2020 fare collection is being temporarily suspended for all services including fixed-route and Connect Mobility paratransit services
 - Anticipated reactivation of fare collection is set as April 1, 2020
 - Designed as a precautionary measure to eliminate the physical contact required between riders & bus operators and money
 - Customer service area of Admin building closed to public, effective 3/18/20
 - Customer service representatives will continue to be available

 - Currently considering homelessness or domestic violence situations to be at greatest need. Will perform a strict triage to determine who is most at risk.
 - All children\parents will be triaged for COVID-19 symptoms & fever

 - Currently have diapers and formula available (Enfamil Gentlease, Enfamil Infant, and Enfamil Neuro Pro).
 - CYFS is waiving the normal paperwork process; however WIC ID is still needed for proof of eligibility
- Pregnancy Resource Center
 - 303 Landmark Drive, #1b, Normal
 - 309-454-5433
 - Medical services will remain open on a limited basis
 - Patients will need to call ahead to determine if services are available
 - Clients may still receive on-site pregnancy tests & limited STD testing
 - Pregnancy classes have been moved to online only
- Center for Hope Outreach
 - Food pantry remains open with modifications for social distancing
 - 90% volunteer staffed; high-risk staff asked to consider not serving; will impact response time but working to address all needs
- Center for Human Services
 - Still fully open; shifting work plans effective 3/17; assessing impact as needs arise
 - Screening for fever at check-in & in exam rooms; socially distancing in lobby
 - Discouraging visitors to supported apartments, no guests nor group activities inside rooming house, clients staying in rooms

 - No longer accepting walk-in admissions for behavioral health programs
