  - ☐ targeted mini lesson, reading strategies, small group instruction, and individual conferencing
  - ☐ independent reading at students level
- Assessed with rubrics, response journals, running records, and conferencing notes.
- Grammar lessons embedded



## **Word Study**

- Words Their Way
  - ☐ spelling, phonics, and vocabulary program
- Spelling sorts instead of lists
  - ☐ sent home weekly
- Activities/Games for daily practice
- Spelling and word patterns are assessed through written tests



# Writing

- Cursive is strongly encouraged
- Writing Workshop approach
  - I learning the process with graphic organizers and outlines
  - □ writer's craft, genre, and mechanics of writing
- Assessed through a writer's notebook, rubrics, and final products



#### Homework

- Typically should not exceed 30 minutes a night
- Will not be given every night
- At home reading, practice math flashcards or skills using IXL, and WTW sorts
- May or may not be assessed, but is for practice and responsibility
