C. Homework Organization

1. Start on front of page
2. Paper heading in upper right hand corner:
NAME
DATE
ASSIGN #
PAGE # & PROBLEMS
3. Work down the page in columns
4. Maximum of three columns per side
5. **Copy original problem within reason and show all work**
6. Work is done with pencil in a neat and orderly fashion
7. **Box** each answer, label units, sentence for word problems
8. Skip one line between problems

E. Guidelines for Success

1. Always remember that **YOU** control your learning

4. Raise your hand and ask questions
5. Stay up-to-date on assignments
