Unit 5 is committed to ensuring that our families continue to receive resources during this extended school closure due to COVID-19. Though all Unit 5 schools will be closed, cold breakfast and sack lunch “Grab and Go” meals will be made available to students in need.

Parents, guardians, and students can pick up the meals. All that is needed to receive a “Grab and Go” meal is a student’s name, grade, and school. The child does not need to be present.
