Kindergarten Readiness: Social Skills

- Complete 2 step directions
- Sit and listen to someone read a story for 5-10 minutes
- Take turns and sharing while playing
- Play a game and accept losing
- Control emotions without a tantrum



Kindergarten Readiness: Fine Motor Skills

- Holds a pencil with proper grip
- Writes first name
- Use scissors to cut basic shapes
- Trace lines and shapes
- Color or draw a picture
- Work on fine motor skills with playdough, Legos, sand, etc.



Kindergarten Readiness: Self Help Skills

- Use the bathroom independently
- Zips and unzips coat
- Takes shoes on and off
- Button/Snap pant fasteners
- Recognizes first and last name
- Take responsibility for cleaning up messes
- Solves problems independently when applicable

Kindergarten Readiness: Academic Skills

- Count to 20 and recognize numbers 0-10
- Practice letters and their sounds
- Follows adults directions
 - Do not tell adults no
- Build self esteem by allowing children to struggle
- Read with your child as often as possible
- Practice identifying colors and shapes

Arrival & Dismissal

There are several different ways to come to school and to leave to go home. Be sure that your child knows how they are coming and going. If your child will be riding a bus, help them to learn the number before school starts!



MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS for KINDERGARTEN

MUST HAVE TO ATTEND:

- 1. PHYSICAL EXAMINATION dated August 15, 2023 or after.
- 2. **COMPLETE IMMUNIZATION RECORD** including kindergarten booster shots given on/after 4th birthday
- 3. **PHYSICAL** and **IMMUNIZATION** forms must be turned in **before** the first day of school or student will be excluded from school until forms are submitted.



MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS for KINDERGARTEN

REQUIRED (But NOT Excluded from school)

- 1. VISION EXAM dated August 15, 2023 or after
- 2. DENTAL EXAM dated November 15-2023 or after


