## 9) New Business

- a. Mrs. Mroz- Close Pin puppetry- for \$575 they would create a puppet show for each of the four Benjamin Elementary winning young author story winners. As long as this is what they want to go forward with

- e. Special Guests: We had two special guests at PTO this month. Mrs Current presented about the Literacy Program and Mrs. Romero presented about the Music program.
  - i. Literacy Program: Leveled book sets for guided reading groups. Benefits of guided reading groups allow for continual reading progress in small group instruction; allowing teachers to meet the needs of ALL students more easily. The ask: Request of PTO to purchase guided reading book text sets for our school book room, (which will include text sets, genre sets, big books, mentor texts, etc.) The district will provide some support for purchasing these books, but with our high number of students we need more. Leveled book sets generally come in sets of 6 (six books given for each title). Questions- how many would we need to be successful? As many as possible- we have SO many students, and we need multiple titles at EVERY level.
  - ii. **Mrs. Romero- Music teacher** would like money to purchase Musicals for their performance in May. Includes different programs for each grade: Hats (grade 2); Update Earth (grade 3); I Need a Vacation (grade 4); Go West (grade 5). Approximately \$350 to cover all CDs, speaking material, and guide to tie this to the classroom. Rights are given to THIS school only, and reusable as many times as we want them. (Note: Mrs. Romero used the money the PTO gave to each teacher at the beginning of the year to purchase the Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade musical programs. This would just be doing the same for the upper grades.

Discussion and Voting:

- Motion to approve \$350 from the wish list made by Zac Pershall and seconded by Apsara to purchase music programs for grades 2-5 music concerts.
- Motion to donate \$2000 from the wish list made by Zac Pershall and seconded by Kiersten Douglass. Any other money remaining at the end of the school year can be revisited to see what other money we may be able to donate.
