The most recent property tax increase will expire in 2015 so this is a way to come up with a funding solution for the schools in McLean County. The tax revenue will go specifically to security, technology and facilities (for both building new and renovating schools). March 18<sup>th</sup> is the vote. Referendum committee is in need of canvassing volunteers to go door to door. Canvassing dates are Sat Feb 22<sup>nd</sup>, March 1<sup>st</sup> and March 8<sup>th</sup> and you will be given specific neighborhoods and houses to canvas with a script and tools to help track.
