Did you know that, to improve energy efficiency, KJHS is in the process of a 2-year geothermal project?

The geothermal project began last summer with the installation of a new boiler, and has continued throughout the year, primarily in the boiler room and other non-student areas.

After baseball season ended, contractors began drilling a bore field near the south parking lot. They have worked all winter long so the ground will be ready for students to use in fall of 2020. Below is a photo of the bore field recently.
