HOW DO I GET A LIBRARY CARD?

Anyone living in Normal is eligible for a free library card. To apply for a card, please visit our website or call us at 309.452.1757.

WHAT CAN I BORROW?

Visit our website, normalpl.org, and search the catalog to explore the wide variety of books, magazines, movies, board games, tech toys, and more available for you to borrow for free. Eligible items will automatically renew after your two week check out period. You will be notified of new due dates by email.

HOW DO I GET MY MATERIALS?

Place your hold requests through our online catalog, the RSAcat mobile app, or by calling us at 309.452.1757. We will contact you by email or phone when your items are ready. Stop by the service desk to pick up your holds or use **Curb It**, our curbside service. If using Curb It, pull into one of the numbered spots in our main parking lot. Call or text the posted number to let us know when you arrive. Pop your trunk or open a door and staff will place your items in your vehicle.



Home delivery service is available to residents who find it difficult to leave their own homes without assistance, or who are confined to their homes for any reason. If you are interested in receiving home delivery service, please call 309.452.1757 and ask for our home delivery staff.

HOW DO I FIND ITEMS TO CHECK OUT?

Use our online catalog, RSAcat mobile app, or give us a call at 309.452.1757 to find your books and put them on hold. Not sure exactly what you feel like reading? Fill out the Browser Pack form on our website and let us surprise you with a selection of items chosen to fit your tastes. Browser Packs are great for families—you can request books for up to four different readers of any age in one pack.

HOW DO I RETURN ITEMS?

You may return items inside the library, to the book return in the library's parking lot, or at any of the off-site book drops around Normal. You are also welcome to return items through our Curb It service.
