#### COVID-19 vaccine update for 5-11 year olds

- Members of the Food and Drug Administration's (FDA's) Vaccines and Related Biological Products Advisory Committee has approved emergency use authorization (EUA) of the vaccine for 5- to 11-year-olds on 10/26
- The decision to grant an EUA now goes to the FDA commissioner.
- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC's) vaccine advisory committee will meet Nov. 2-3 to discuss who should receive the vaccine.
- IF both the FDA and CDC vote YES, then the EUA of the vaccine for 5-11 yo will be granted. Click here for more information regarding the COVID vaccine for 5-11 year olds.


Parkside's dental clinic will be next month. Here is the <u>link</u> to sign your child up. No need to sign up if you have already turned in the dental form consent.
