Students in fifth grade will take the Illinois Science Assessment (ISA) March 7-11. Students in third, fourth and fifth grades will participate in the Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) testing March 28-April 8. The IAR is designed to measure each student's current performance in relation to the Illinois Learning Standards for mathematics and English language arts (ELA).

Students typically do better on the tests when they take them as scheduled with their class. Please do not schedule appointments or vacations during testing. Thank you in advance for helping your child be prepared with breakfast and adequate sleep. Elementary students need 9-12 hours of sleep each night according to the American Academy of Pediatrics. It is also very important that students eat a healthy breakfast, full of proteins and fruits. Thanks in advance for helping our students be ready to show what they know at test time!

March should being some slightly warmer days and outside recess. Students will need reminders to continue to bring coats for the chilly spring temperatures and winds.

Nurse's Notes from Mrs. Goff For everyone's protection, sick children must be at home, not at school. When reporting the student's absence, please report the reason for the child's absence. The school needs to be informed of any student having a special health problem or communicable disease. Children with the following conditions should not be in school:

- A fever within the last 24 hours of 100° F or higher
- Vomiting or diarrhea within the last 24 hours
- A frequent or disruptive cough or other signs of an acute respiratory infection
- Any contagious illness such as "strep throat" that requires antibiotic therapy. Once a student has been fever free without use of fever-reducing medications and on antibiotics for at least 24 hours, he/she may return to school.
- Any undiagnosed skin rash. A student with a rash may attend school upon presenting a physician's note stating the rash is not contagious.
- Pronounced lethargy or fatigue that interferes with participation in learning activities.
